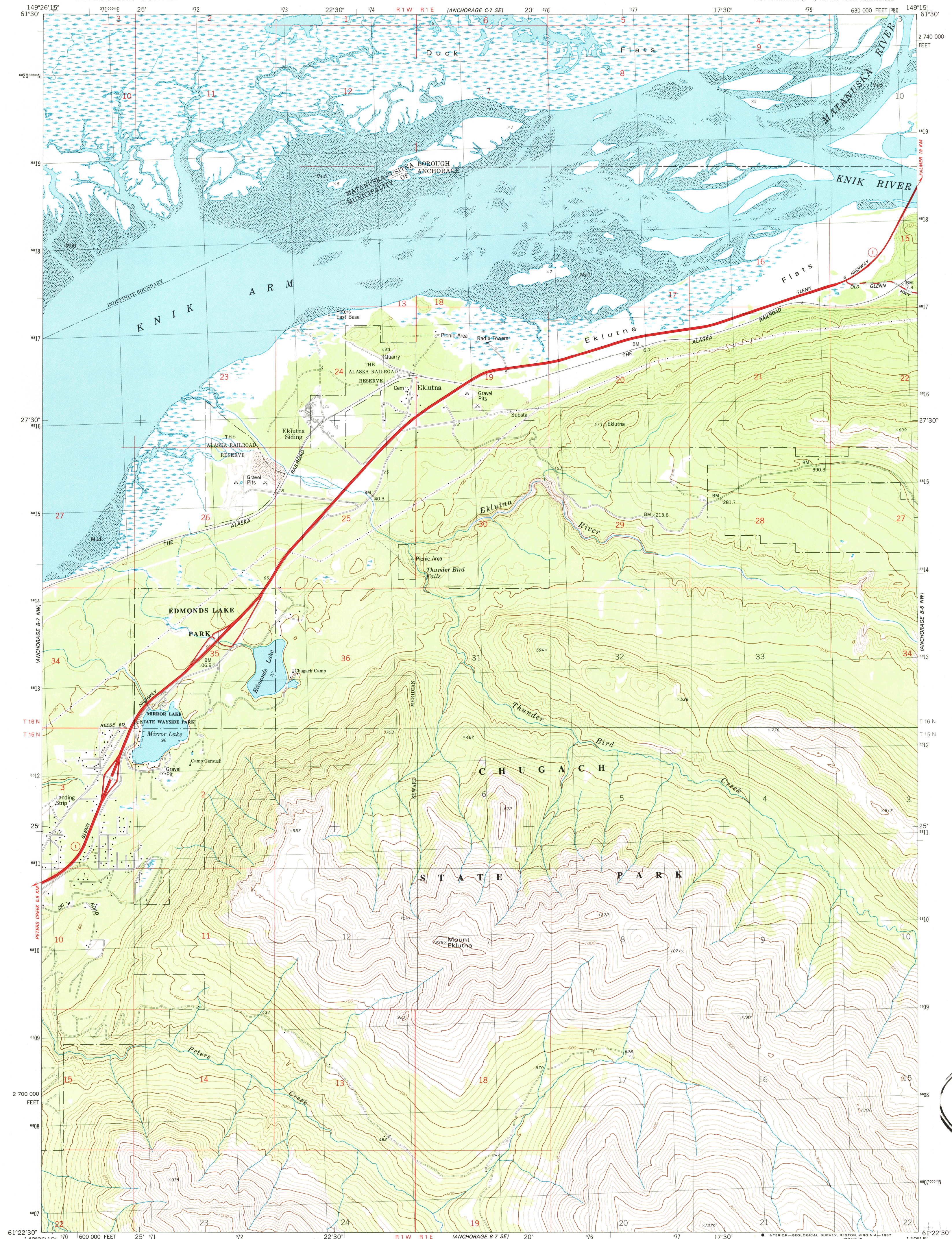


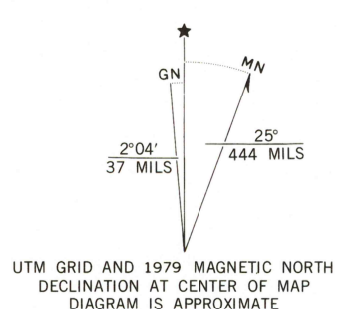

Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folios S-13 and S-14, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
