

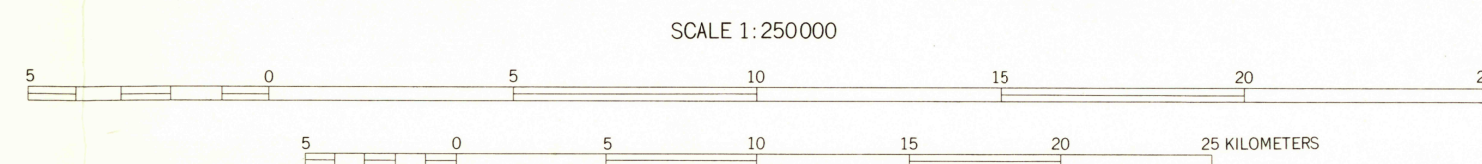

ZONE 4, SHOWN IN BLUE

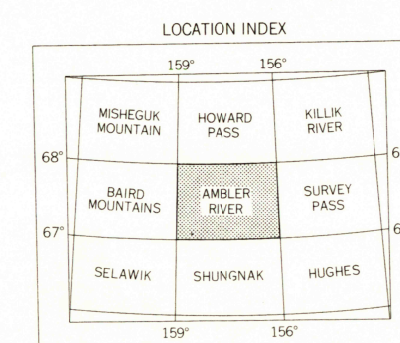
LAND LINES REPRESENT UNSURVEYED AND UNMARKED LOCATIONS
