






DASHED LAND LINES INDICATE APPROXIMATE LOCATION




1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAP 39 ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE

4. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAP 38 ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE


