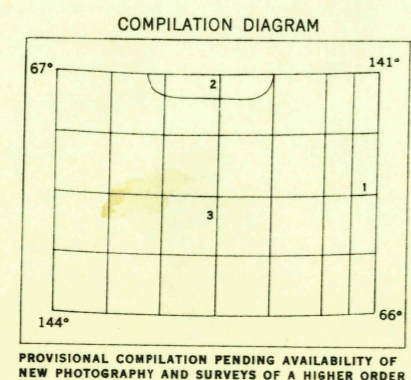
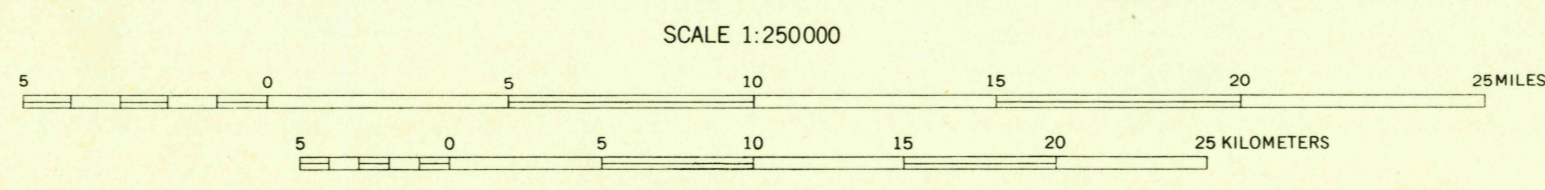

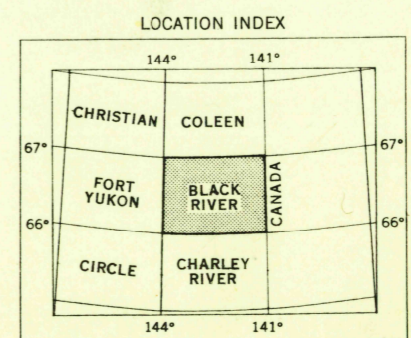
1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM IBC MAPS, 1:62,500, 1938
