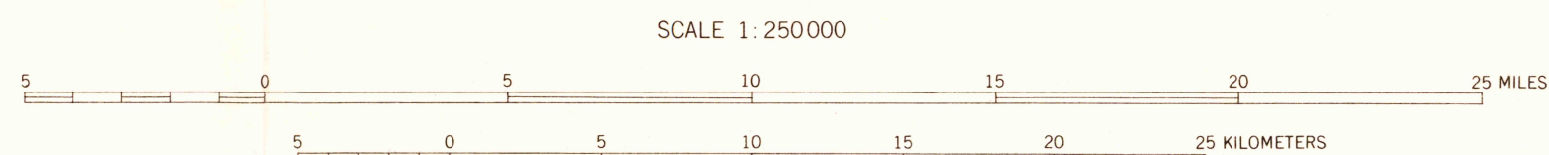
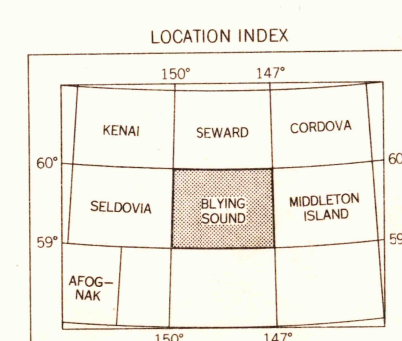


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AND 1953 AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN 1950, 1951, AND 1952
