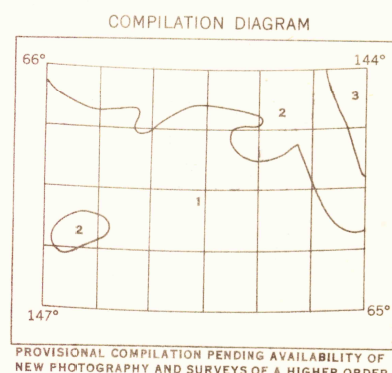




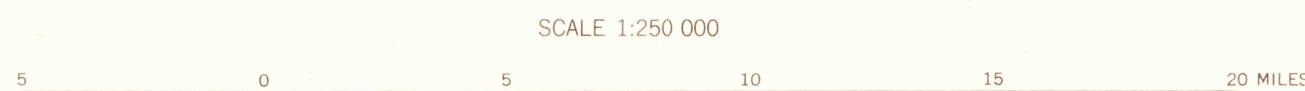

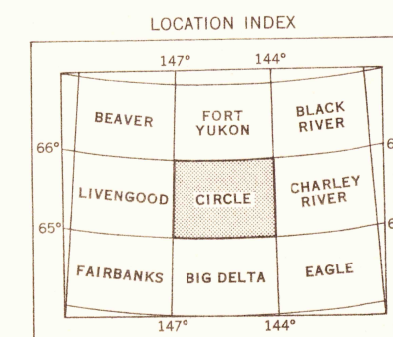


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAPS
