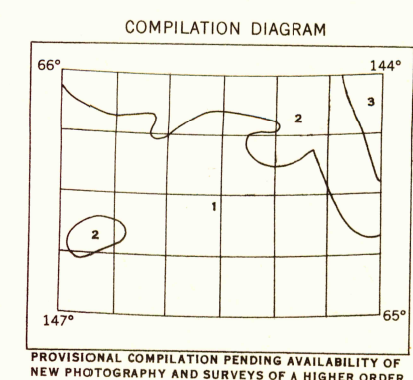


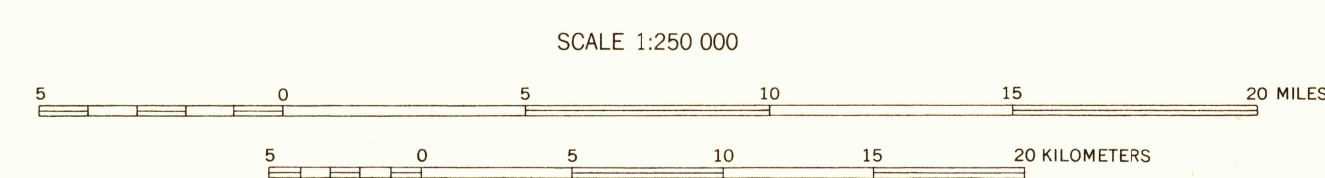

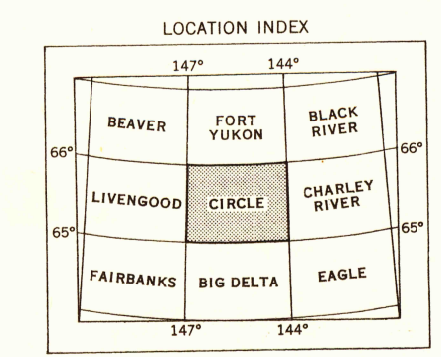


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAPS 27, 28 AND 29 ADJUSTED TO THE TIDE GAUGE BASE.
