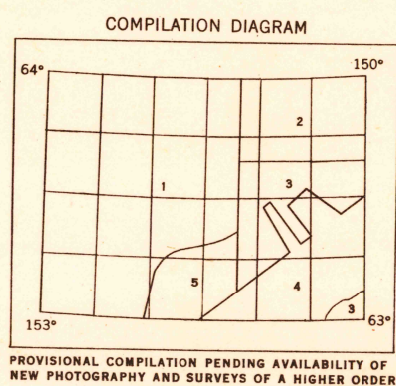
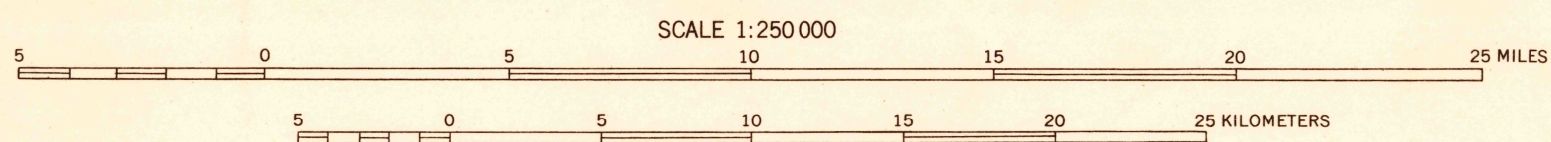

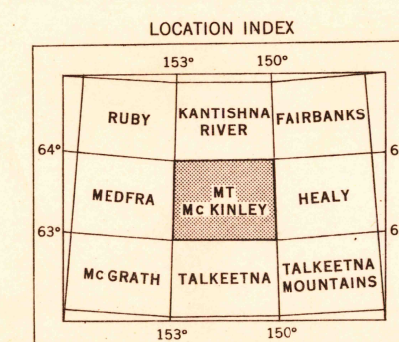


1. PLANIMETRY FROM TRIMETROGON
