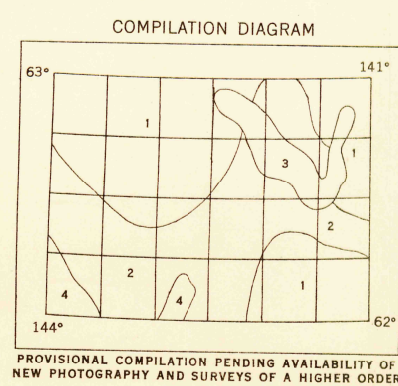


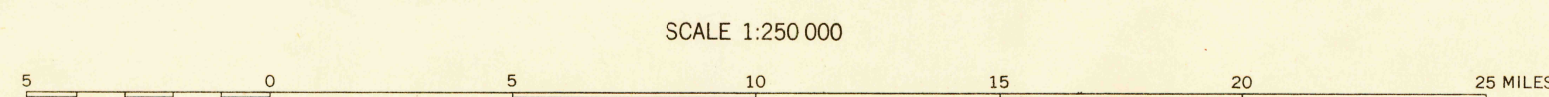


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CULTURE AND DRAINAGE IN PART COMPILED FROM TRIMETROGRAM PHOTOGRAPHY, 1948

UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 7

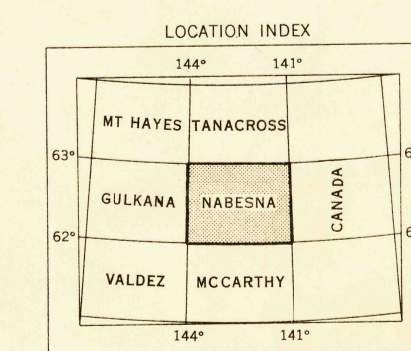
