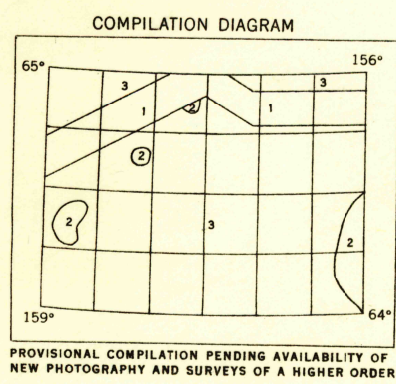
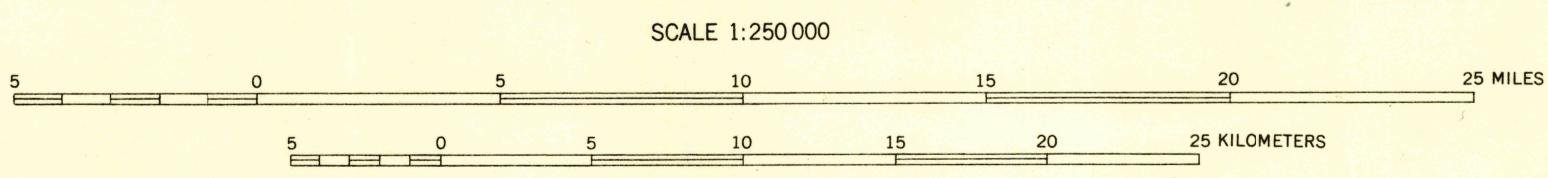

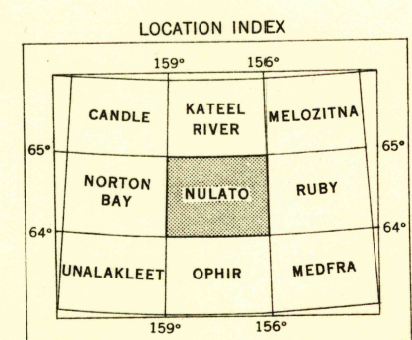


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM USGS MULTIPLEX COMPILATION ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE
