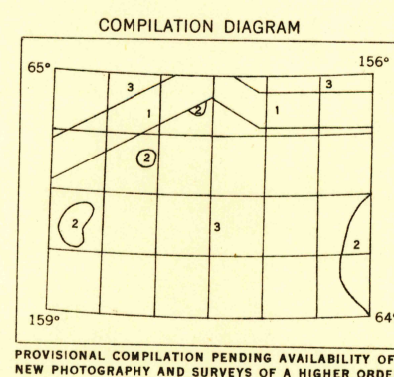

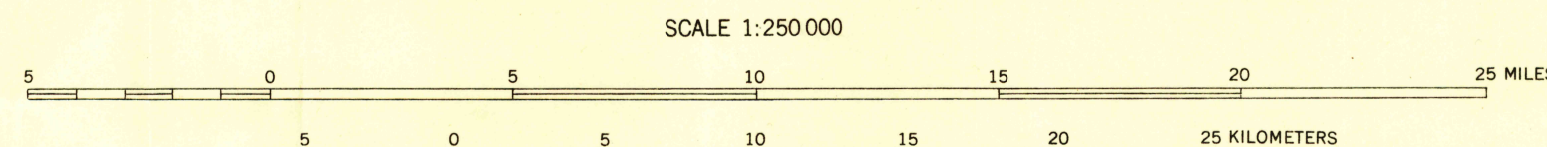

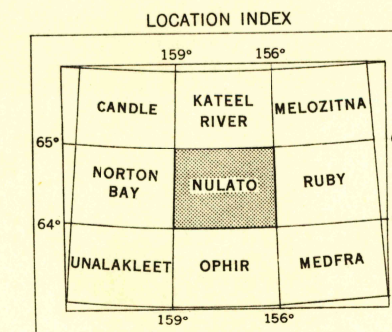


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM USGS MULTIPLEX COMPILED ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGRAM BASE
