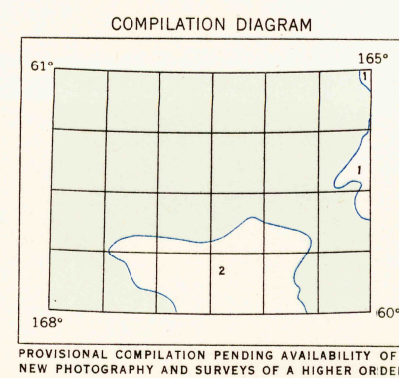

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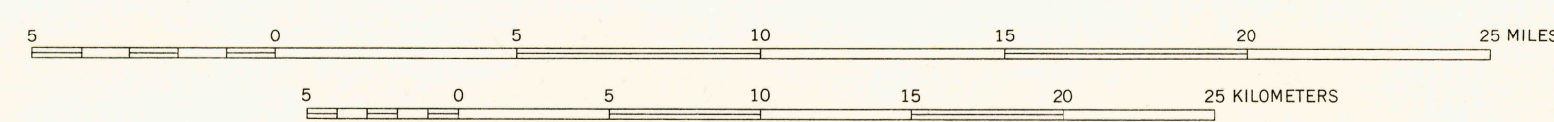

2. TOPOGRAPHY FROM PHOTOALTADE METHODS ADJUSTED TO PLANIMETRY OF USAF MAP 1318

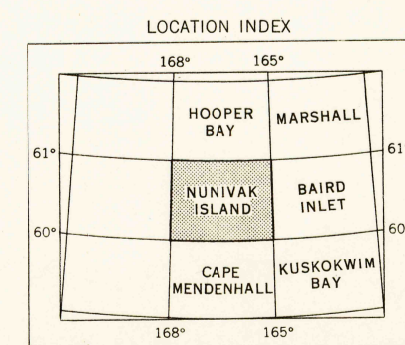
