

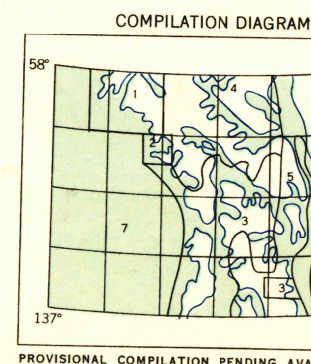

EXCEPT SITKA AND PELICAN EXCLUSION AREAS



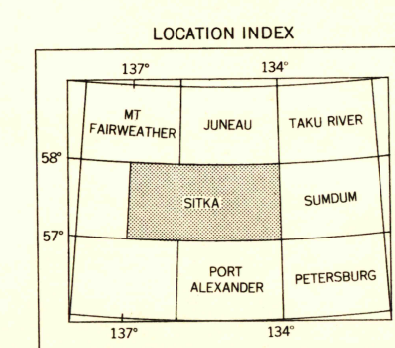
