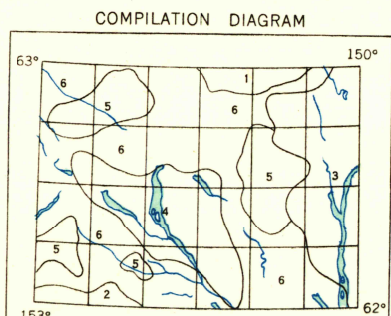


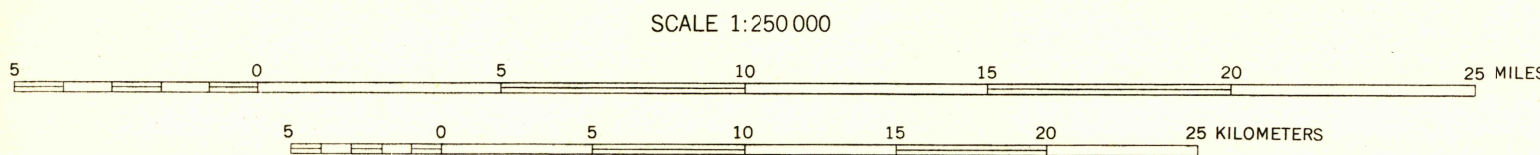

DASHED LAND LINES INDICATE APPROXIMATE LOCATION



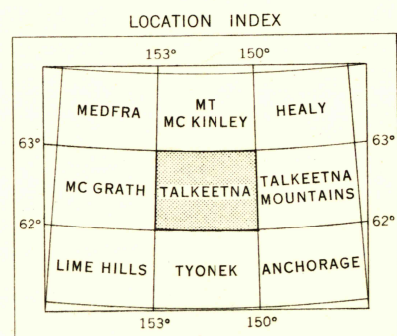
