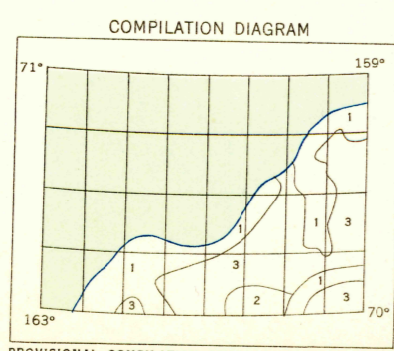


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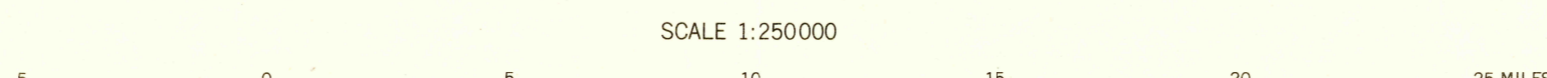
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UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONES 3 AND 4 1945 BARROW DATUM



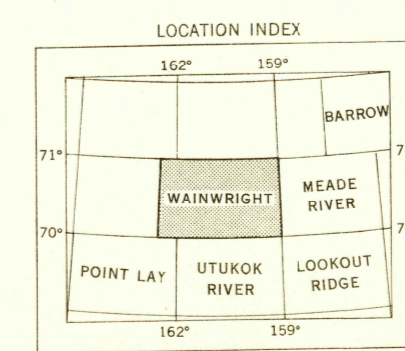
