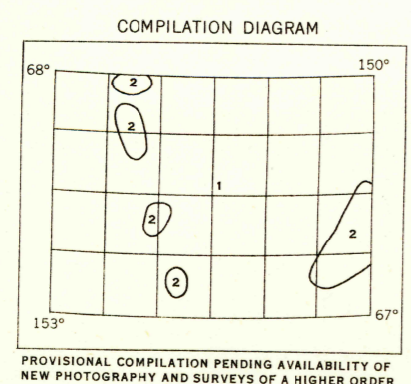


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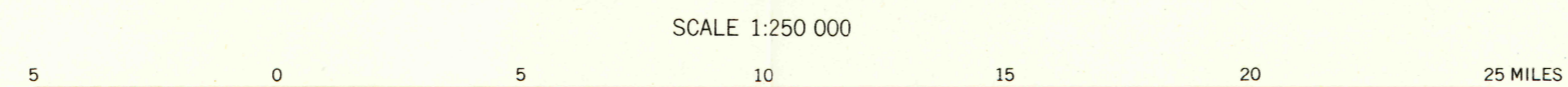
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UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 5

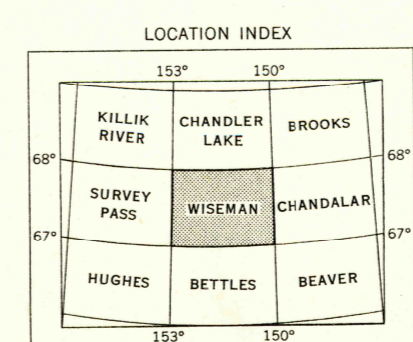
1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM PHOTOGRAMMATIC COMPILED AND ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGN BASE
