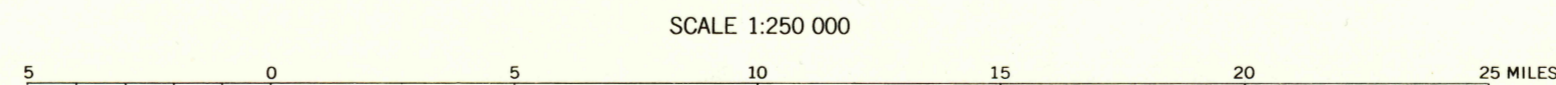
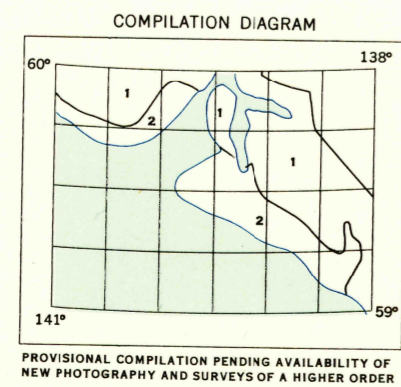
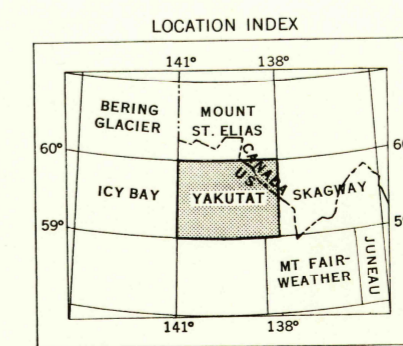


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UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 7 1927 NORTH AMERICAN DATUM
