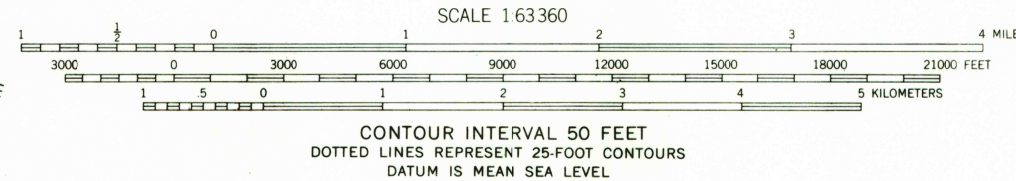
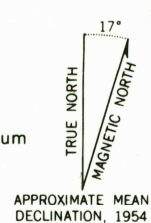
BAIRD INLET (C-7) QUADRANGLE
