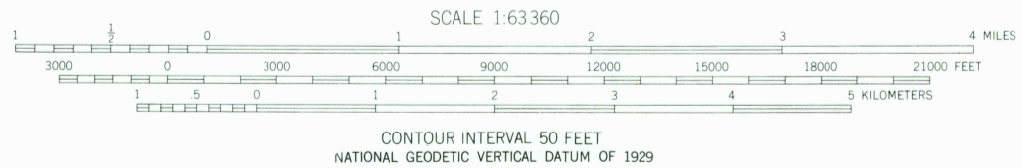
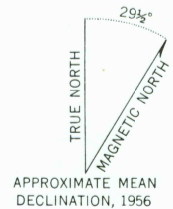

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs

the projection lines 47 meters north and 118 meters east
