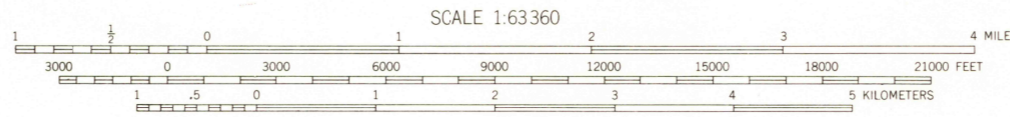

Folio K-6, Kateel River Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
