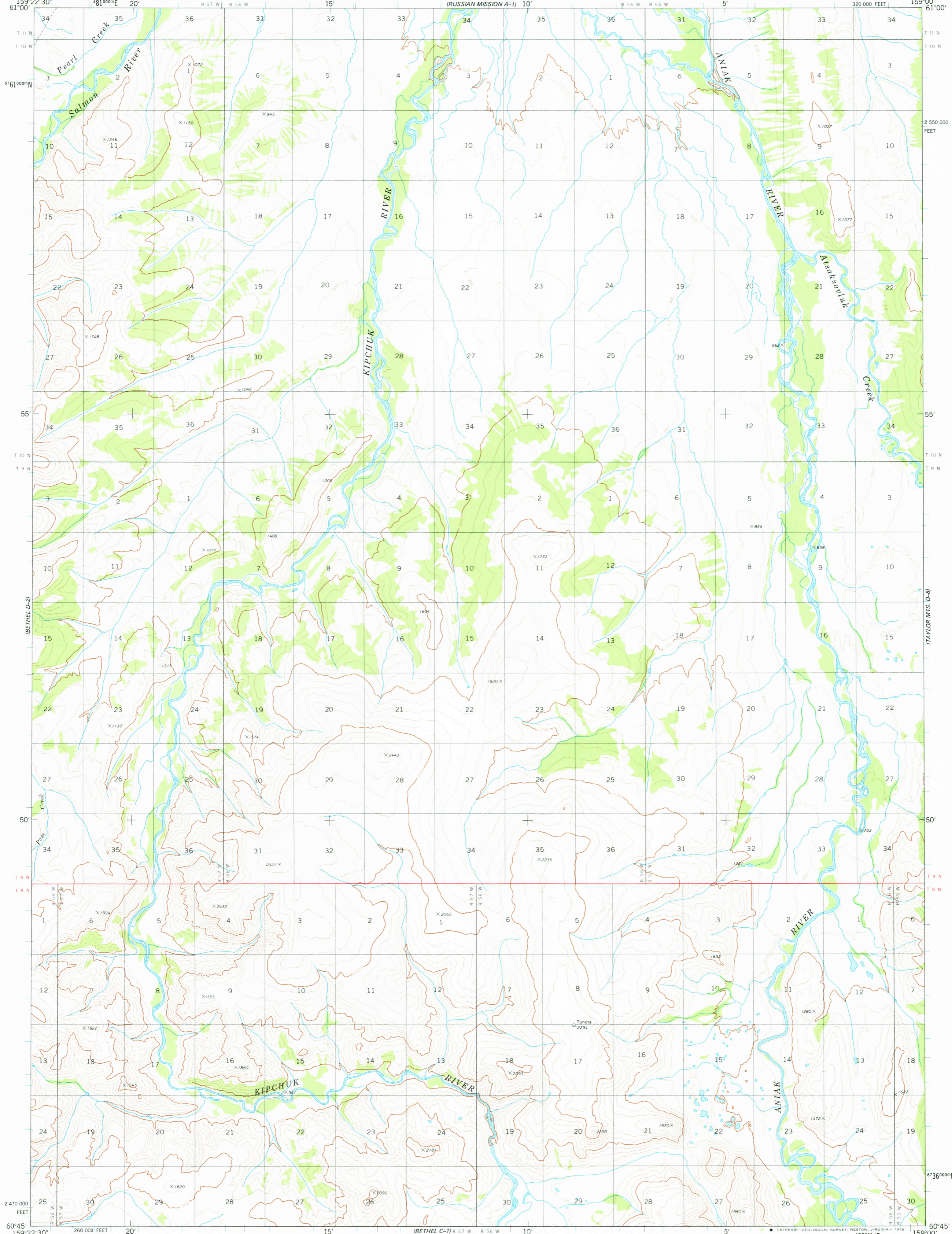

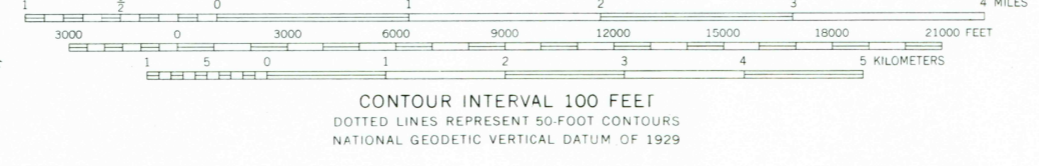
BETHEL (D-1) QUADRANGLE
