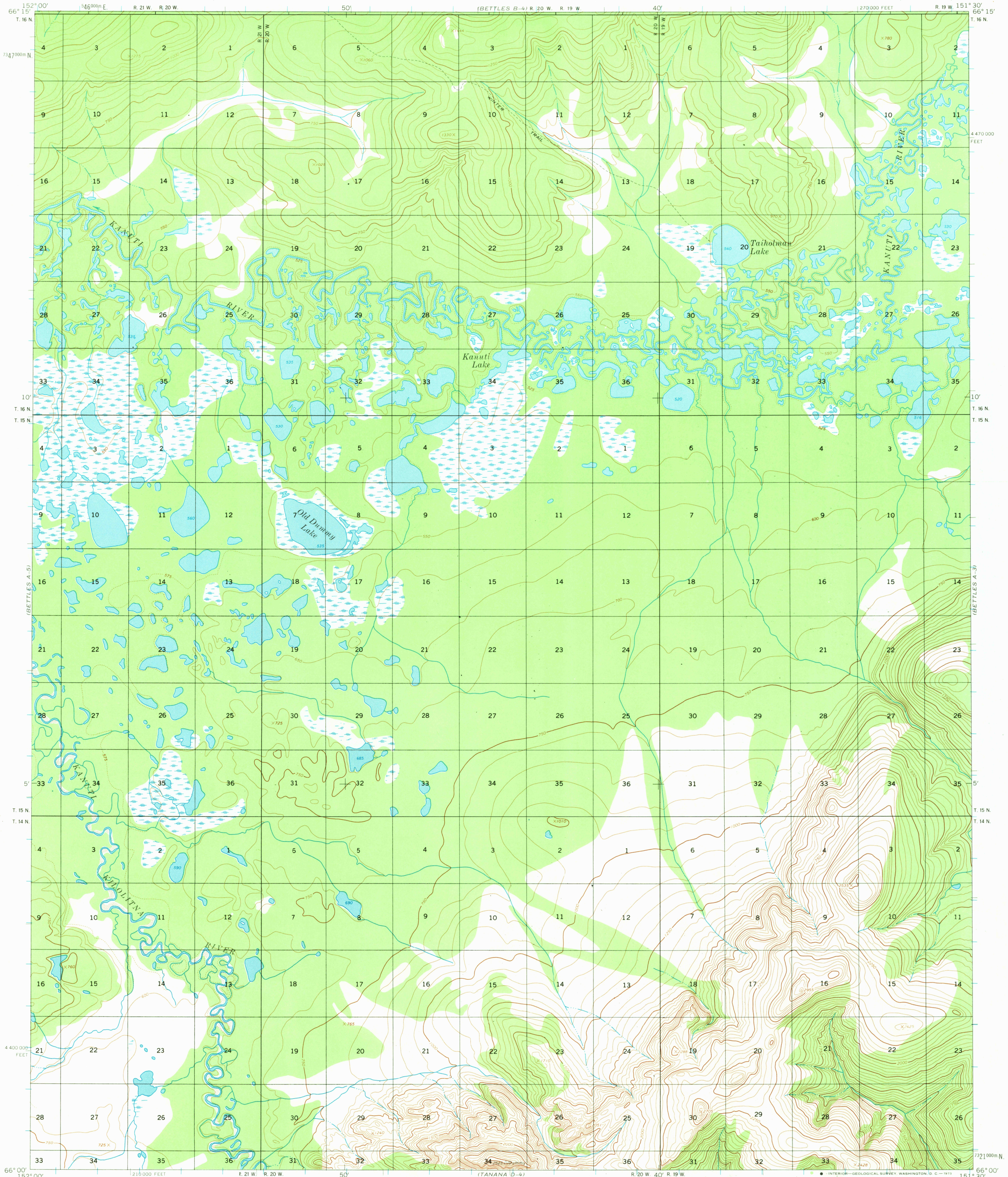

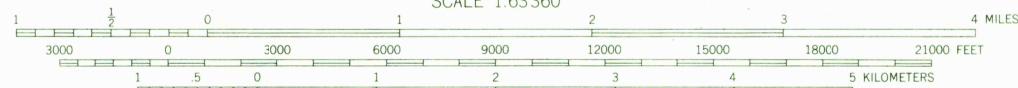

Universal Transverse Mercator projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 4 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 5, shown in blue

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folios F-4 and F-5, Fairbanks Meridian

Swamps, as portrayed indicate only wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
