

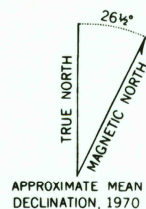

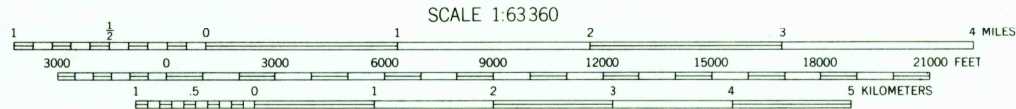
Universal Transverse Mercator projection. 1927 North American datum
