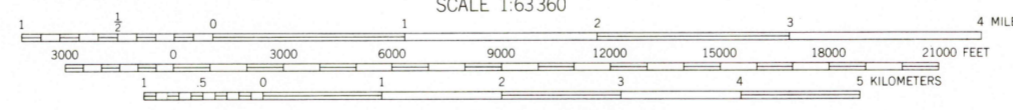
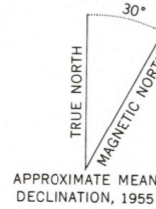

Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks shown in blue:  
Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 6  
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alaska coordinate  
system, zone 3, 1927 North American Datum  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move  
the projection lines 45 meters north and 113 meters east  
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations  
determined by the Bureau of Land Management  
Folios F-8, Fairbanks Meridian and CR-1 Copper River Meridian  
Swamp, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,  
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
