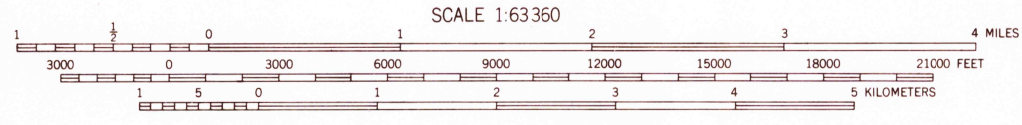
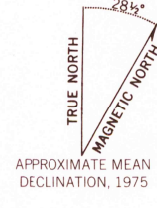
BIG DELTA (B-6) QUADRANGLE
