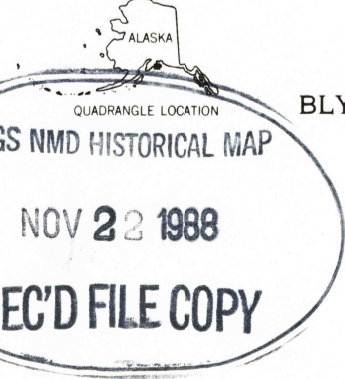

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 63 meters north and 117 meters east.  
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-15, Seward Meridian.  
The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of all the public lands in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of Alaska consisting of islands, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires, as well as designated mainland areas. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs. Federal reservation boundaries established by The Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act, PL-96-487, Dec. 2, 1980, are shown as compiled by the administering agencies. Entire land area is within the Chugach National Forest.
