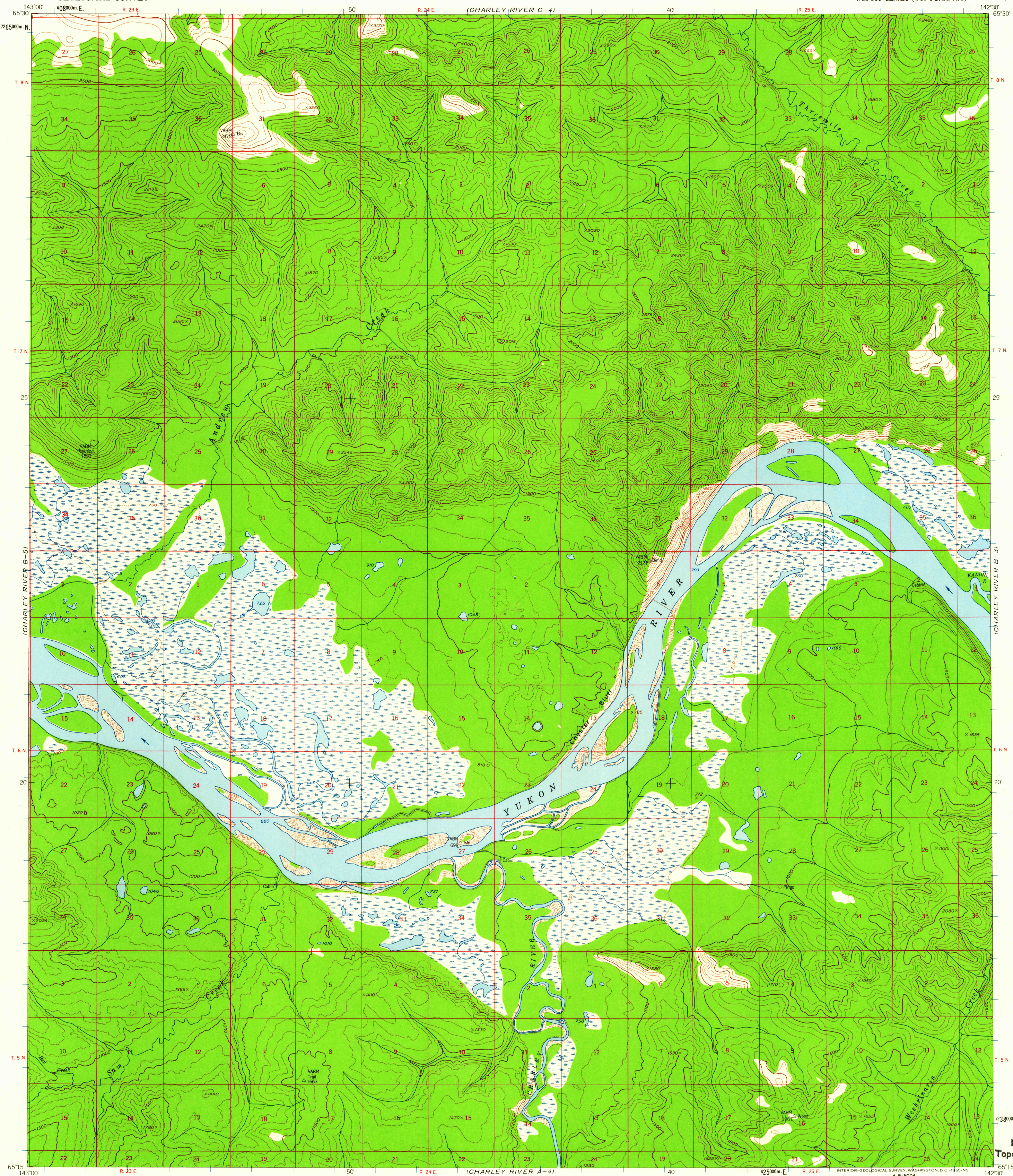
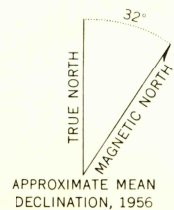

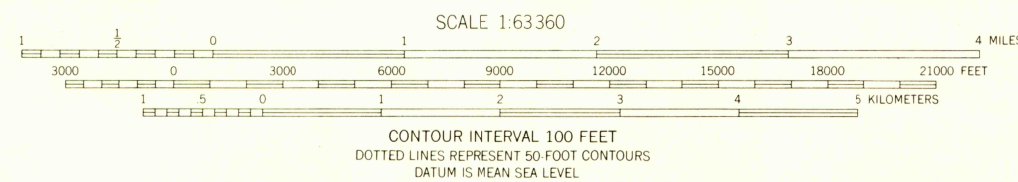
CHARLEY RIVER (B-4) QUADRANGLE
