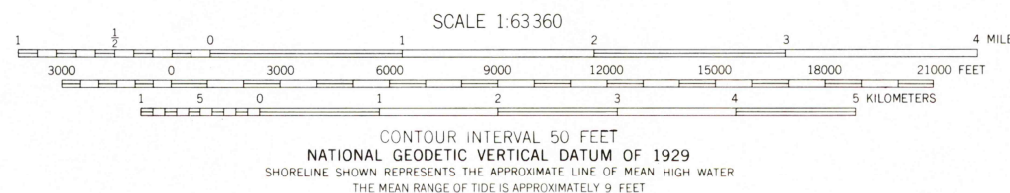

Folio S-27, Seward Meridian
