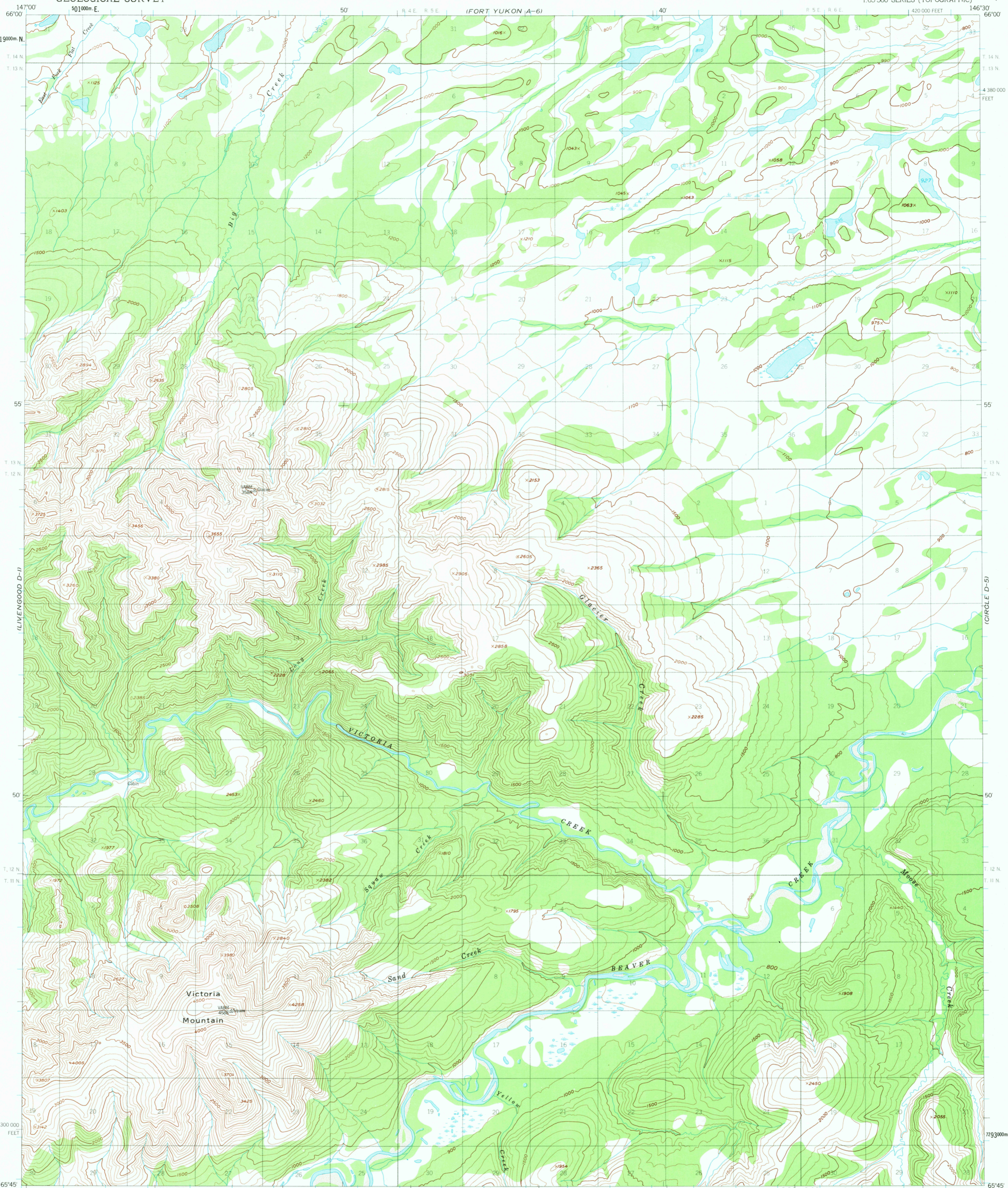

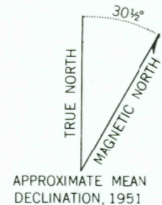

Universal Transverse Mercator projection, 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 3 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 6 shown in blue

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Foto F 7, Fairbanks Meridian

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 46 meters north and 116 meters east
