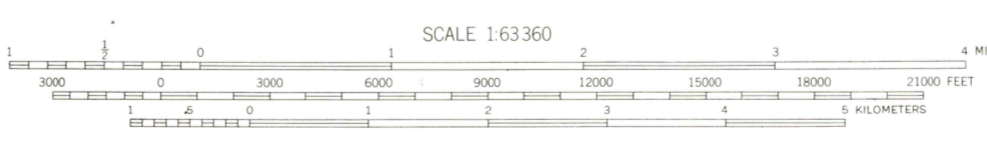
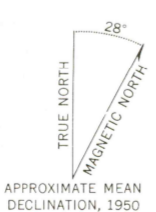

system, zone 3, 1927 North American Datum  
To place on the predated North American Datum 1983 move  
the projection lines 54 meters north and 112 meters east  
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations  
determined by the Bureau of Land Management  
Folios CR-6 and CR-10, Copper River Meridian  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,  
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of  
the National or State reservations shown on this map
