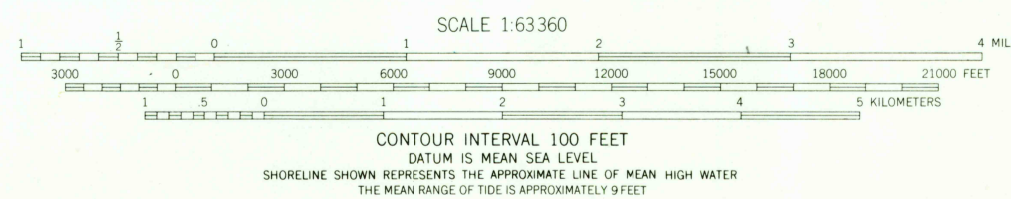
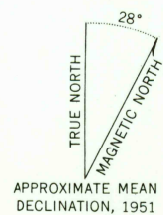

Universal Transverse Mercator projection, 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 3 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 6, shown in blue.
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio CR-5, Copper River Meridian.
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
Entire land area is within the Chugach National Forest.
