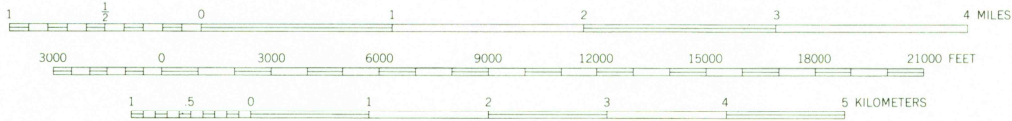

Entire land area is within the Tongass National Forest except Hyaburg exclusion area
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
Lake elevations are unchecked
