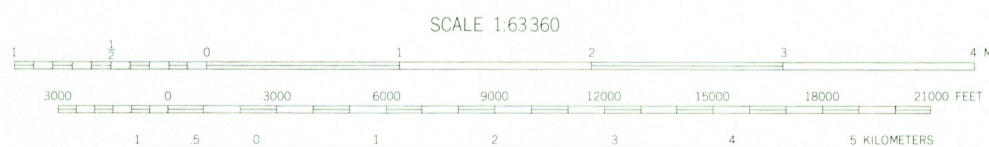
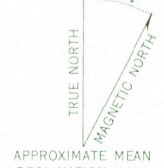
CRAIG (C-5) QUADRANGLE
