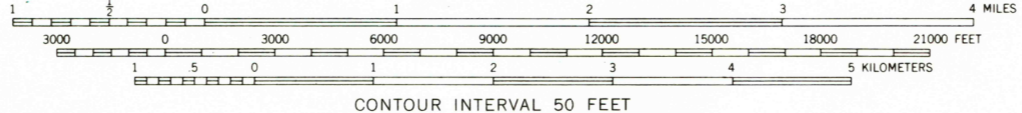
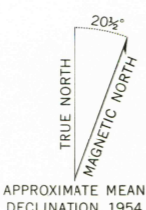

10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 6
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
zone 4, shown in blue
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations
determined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folio S-19, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 80 meters north and 137 meters east
