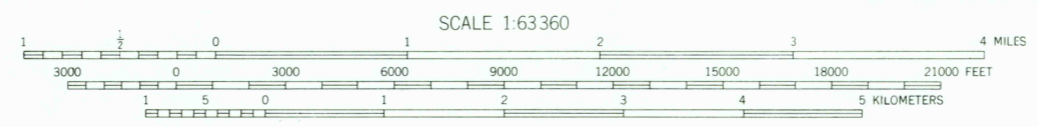

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken in 1972 and 1973. Field annotated 1976. Map not field checked. Map edited 1979.
Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks: Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 4
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 7. 1927 North American datum
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-20, Seward Meridian
Swamps as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 88 meters north and 133 meters east
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
