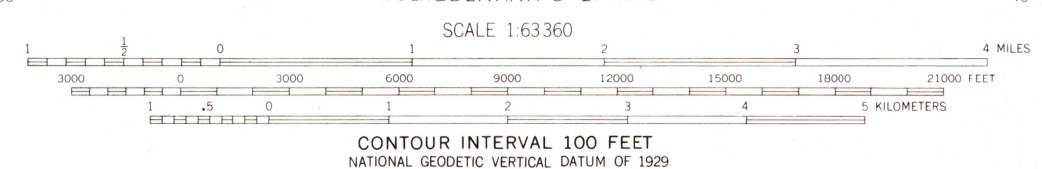
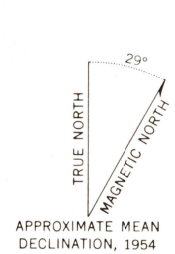

Land lines printed in gray represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folios CR 3, Copper River Meridian and F.9, Fairbanks Meridian.
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 51 meters north and 113 meters east.



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
