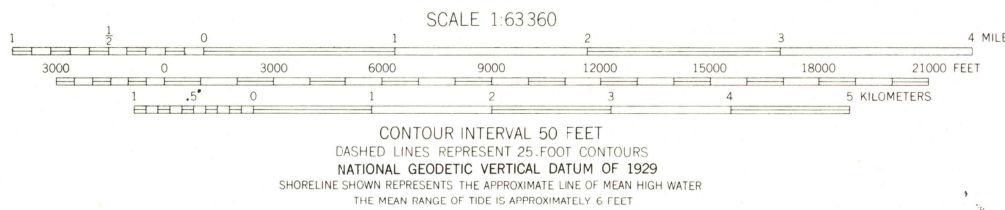
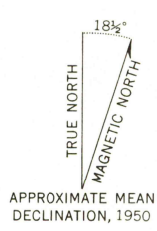

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations
predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folios S-19 and S-20, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
Lake elevations are unchecked
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 88 meters north and 134 meters east
