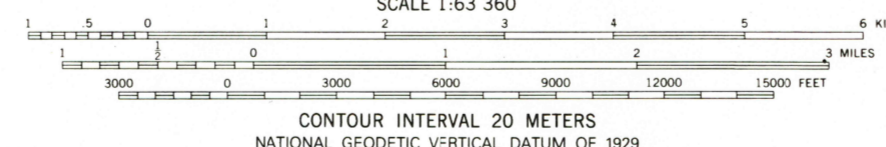
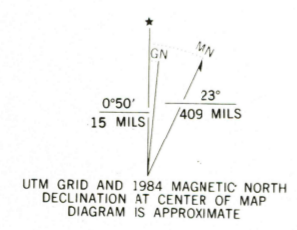

Folio U-9, Umat Meridian, and Folio K-2, Kateel River Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
