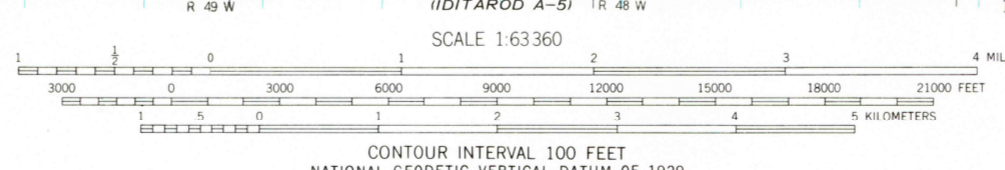
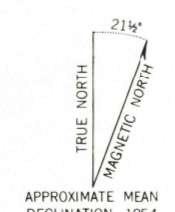

predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folios S-4 and S-5, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 79 meters north and 127 meters east
