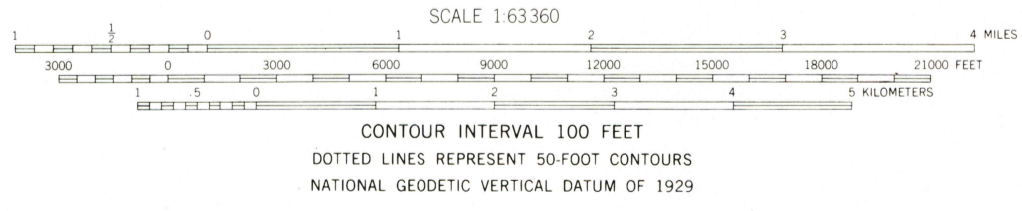
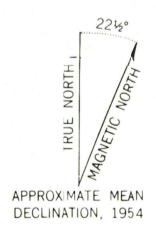


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Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1953, 1954 and 1955, field annotated 1954. Map not field checked

1927 North American datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7.6 meters north and 126 meters east
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folios S-4, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
