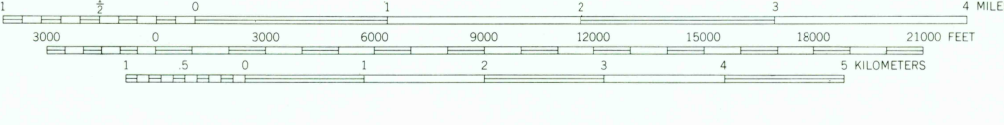
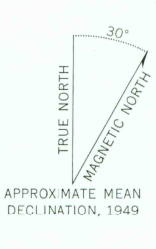
JUNEAU (C-4) QUADRANGLE
