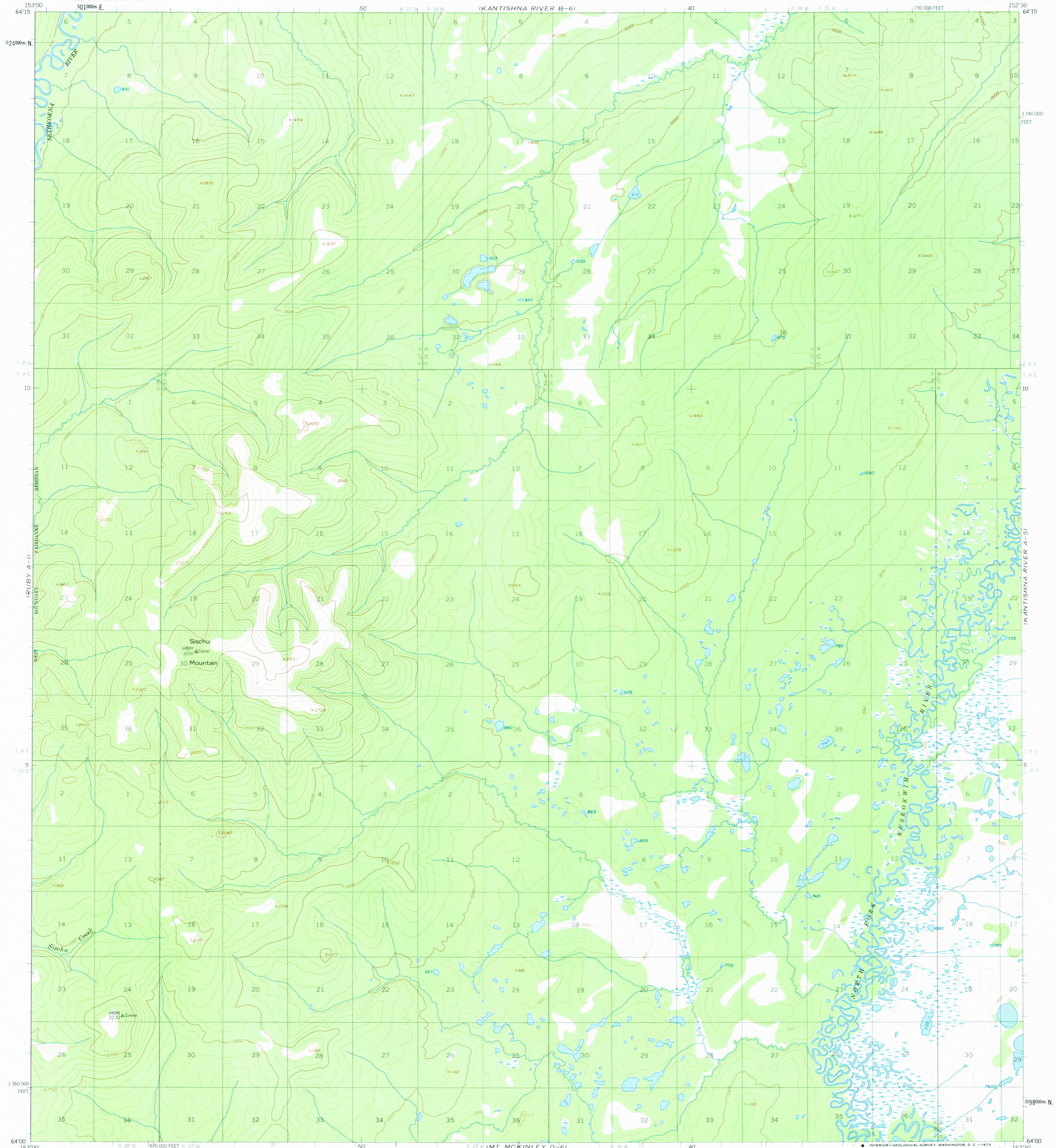

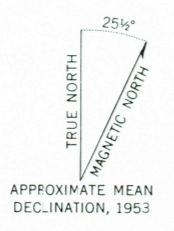
KANTISHNA RIVER (A-6) QUADRANGLE
