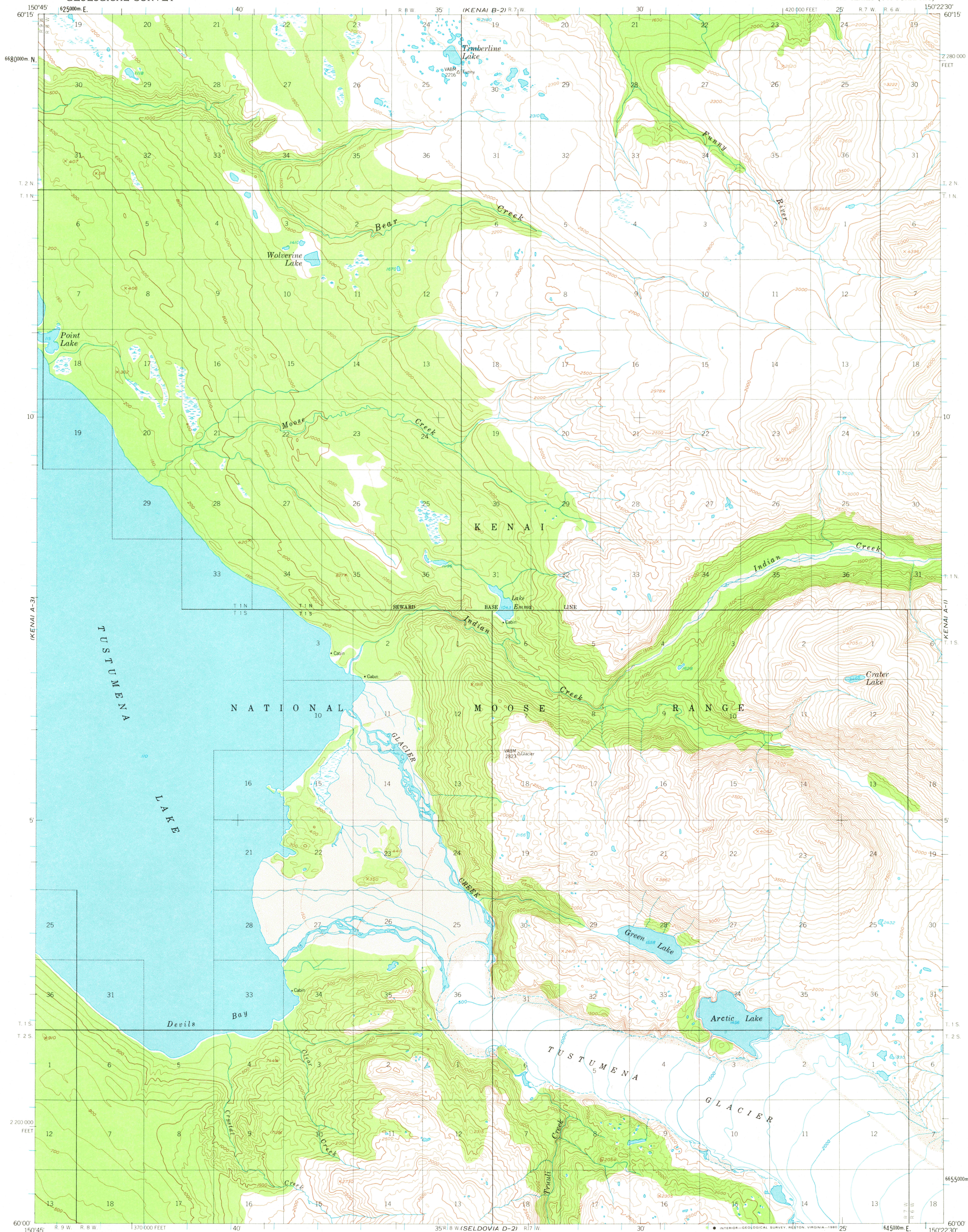

Folio S-16, Seward Meridian

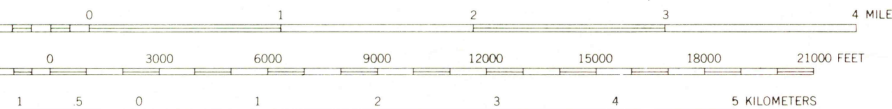
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
