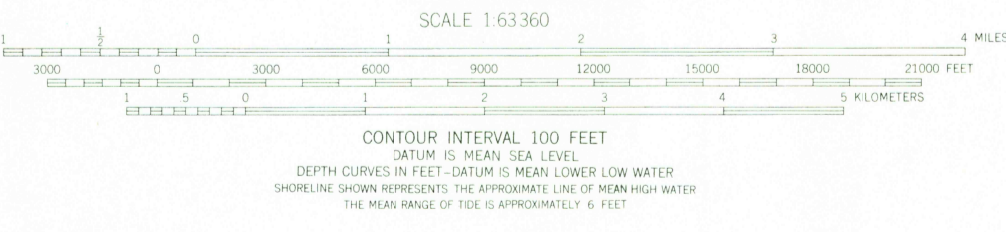
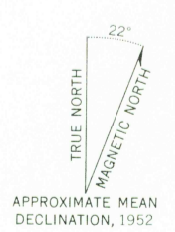
KODIAK (A-5) QUADRANGLE
