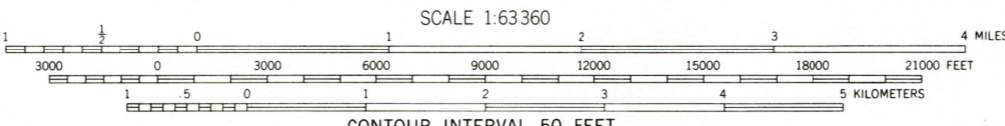

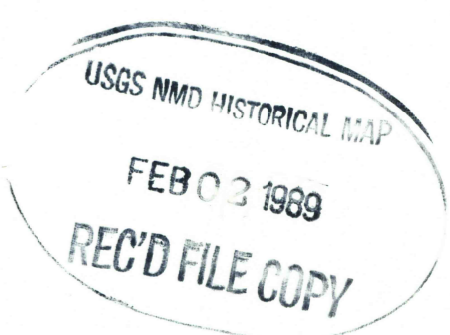

10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 5. 1927 North American Datum.  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 84 meters north and 128 meters east.  
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-23, Seward Meridian.  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs taken 1947.  
The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of all the public lands in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of Alaska consisting of island, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires, as well as designated mainland areas.
