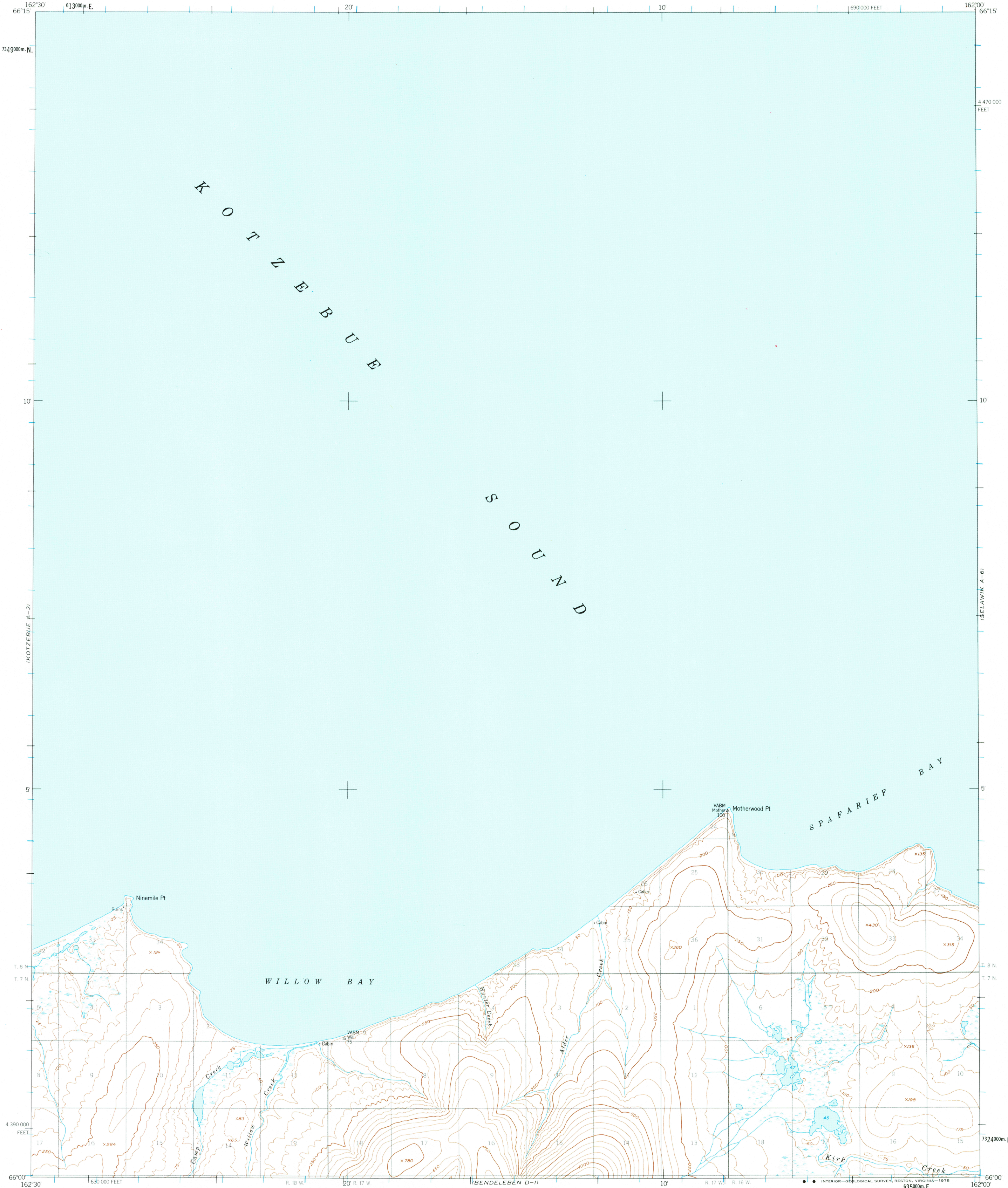

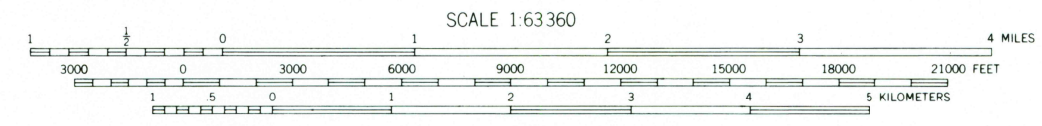
KOTZEBUE (A-1) QUADRANGLE
