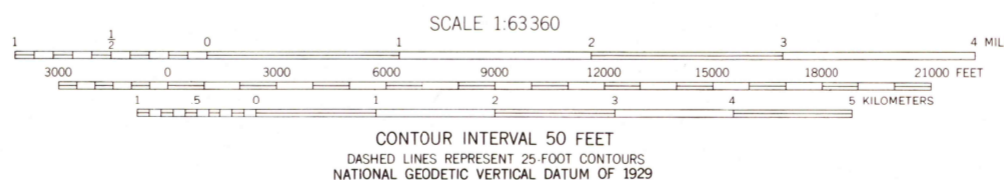
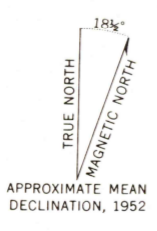


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Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1951. Field annotated 1952. Map not field checked

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-6, Seward Meridian
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 88 meters north and 130 meters east
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
