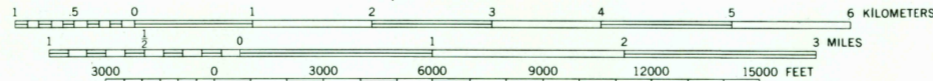
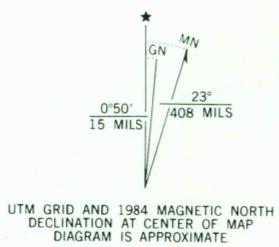
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 60 meters north and 125 meters east
