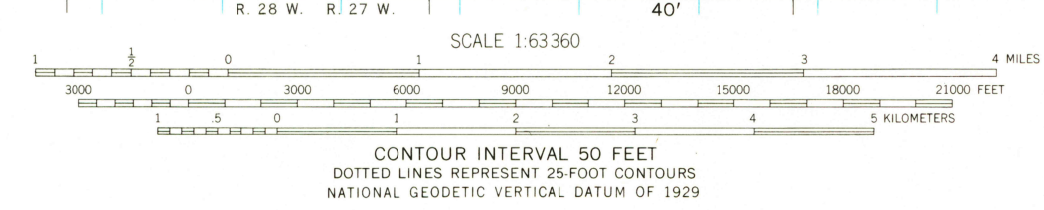

the projection lines 57 meters north and 126 meters east
