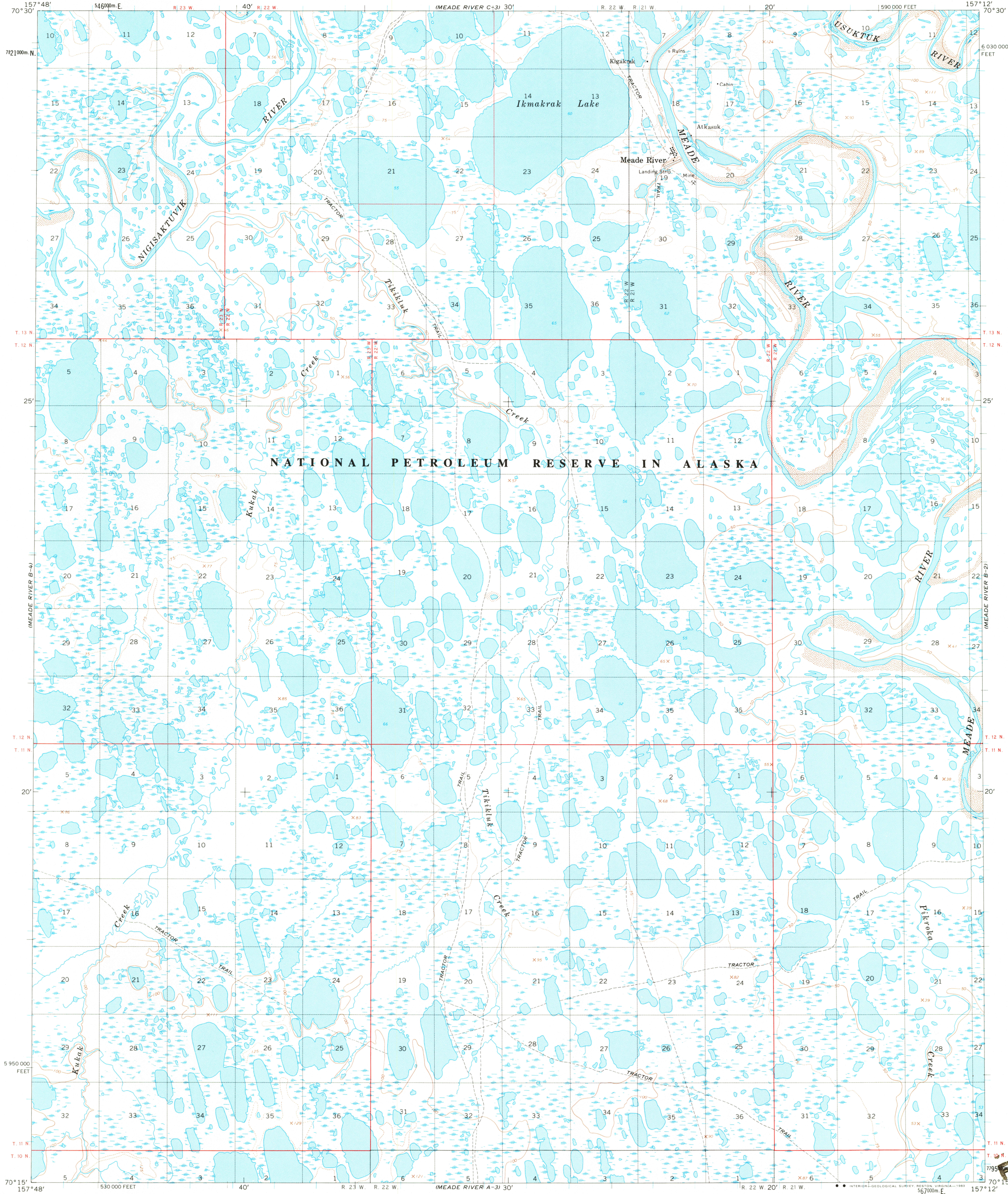

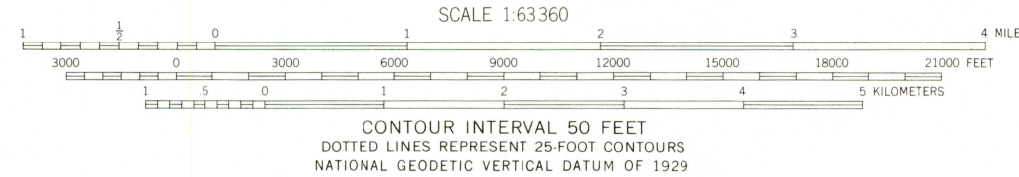
MEADE RIVER (B-3) QUADRANGLE

the projection lines 53 meters north and 126 meters east  
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations  
predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management  
Folio U-5, Umiat Meridian
